


6 PHONE SAFETY TIPS FOR EVERYONE!



Always keep your phone locked

If someone gets hold of your phone, tablet or computer, and there's no lock screen, the person suddenly has access to everything on your device.





Turn off location sharing

Use official app stores only

Keep your device updated

System updates often contain patches
for recently-discovered security
vulnerabilities.





Be cautious with public Wi-Fi

Be careful when you use public wifi. When accessing public networks, anyone can use unsecured networks to distribute malware and access private information.





Monitor app permissions

Learn the privacy settings for any device, app or service you use. Some apps will ask for permission to access photos and other personal information. Stay informed so you aren't sharing anything you don't want to.
